ORDINANCE NO. 4475

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LIBERAL, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE “UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES”, 32<sup>nd</sup> EDITION OF 2016, AND REPEALING AND REPLACING EXISTING SECTION 11-101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LIBERAL, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Liberal, Kansas:

SECTION 1. That existing Section 11-101 of the Code of the City of Liberal, Kansas, is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

“11-101. INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Liberal, Kansas, that certain code known as the “Uniform Public Offense Code,” 32<sup>nd</sup> Edition of 2016, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three (3) copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped “Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 4475,” and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The Uniform Public Offense Code currently adopted by the City shall be amended or supplemented, as the case may be, by all other sections contained in this chapter, regardless of whether such other sections were adopted before or after the current Public Offense Code.”

SECTION 2. CRIMINAL USE OF WEAPONS. Section 10.1 of the Uniform Public Offense Code is amended by adding the following sections:

10.1(a)(11) Possessing, transporting, or carrying any unconcealed loaded (in magazine or chamber) firearm or other dangerous or deadly weapon, except in your business or residence, unless licensed by the State of Kansas or otherwise authorized by Kansas law to do so.

10.1(a)(12) Knowingly possessing any device or attachment designed to be a silencer. (2006; Ord. 4332)

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the *High Plains Daily Leader*, the official city paper.
