

ORDINANCE NO. 4442

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LIBERAL, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES", 30TH EDITION OF 2014, AND REPEALING AND REPLACING EXISTING SECTION 11-101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LIBERAL, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Liberal, Kansas:

SECTION 1. That existing Section 11-101 of the Code of the City of Liberal, Kansas, is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

"11-101. INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE.
There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Liberal, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code," 30th Edition of 2014, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three (3) copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 4442," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The Uniform Public Offense Code currently adopted by the City shall be amended or supplemented, as the case may be, by all other sections contained in this chapter, regardless of whether such other sections were adopted before or after the current Public Offense Code."

SECTION 2. Section 11-116 of the Code of the City of Liberal, Kansas, is hereby amended as follows:

11-116. DANCING. The Uniform Public Offense Code is amended by adding the following section:

11.14 Dancing. It shall be unlawful for any licensee to conduct or operate any public dance in or permit dancing in his or her place of business or in any room or building used directly and principally in connection with the room licensed as a place of business for the sale therein of cereal malt beverage, except at the Mid-America Air Museum for special functions. This section shall not prevent issuance of a license for dancing under the laws of the city governing public dances and dance halls. Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of a Class C violation. (2000, Ord. 4251)

SECTION 3. Section 10.4 of the Uniform Public Offense Code is, hereby, amended to reflect the correct authorizing statute of K.S.A. 2013 Supp. K.S.A. 22-2512 and amendments thereto.

SECTION 4. Section 11.10 of the Uniform Public Offense Code is, hereby, amended to include the following language:

Possession of a gambling device is a Class B violation.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the *High Plains Daily Leader & Times*, the official city paper.
